



# **A Bird's Eye View of NEP-2020 Implementation Framework of Mangalore University**

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# Introduction

- Qualitative changes in undergraduate and postgraduate programs - to cater to the needs of students with **diverse talents, aspirations and professional requirements**.
- NEP 2020 recommended a Multi-disciplinary Undergraduate Program with **multiple exit and entry options** with certificate/Diploma/degrees at each of the exits.
- A **liberal approach to be the basis of undergraduate education** in all disciplines at the undergraduate level.
- Undergraduate curriculum needs to be focussed on **creativity and innovation, critical thinking and higher order thinking capacities, problem solving abilities, team work, communication skills, more in-depth learning and mastery of curricula across fields**

## **Salient Features of the Four Years Multidisciplinary Undergraduate Programmes with Multiple Entry and Exit Options**

- . Structured with multiple exit options with Certificate, Diploma and Basic Bachelor Degree at the completion of first, second and third years, respectively. On completion of the four years Undergraduate Program, either in one stretch or through multiple exits and re-entries, one gets a Bachelor's degree with Honours.**
- . The four years undergraduate Honours degree holders, with research component and a suitable grade, are eligible to enter the 'Doctoral (Ph.D.) Program' in a relevant discipline or to enter 'Two Semester Master's Degree programme with project work'.**

- . The Multidisciplinary Undergraduate Programme program - Both breadth and depth in diverse areas of knowledge. A range of courses are offered with rigorous exposure to multiple disciplines and areas, while specializing in one or two areas.**
- . The programme fulfils knowledge, vocational, professional and skill requirements along-side humanities and arts, social, physical and life sciences, mathematics, sports etc.**
- . The curriculum combines conceptual knowledge with practical engagement and understanding, relevant to real world application through practical laboratory work, field work, internships, workshops and research projects.**
- . A few courses are common to all, contribute to the breadth of study and two areas of specialization provides for depth of study.**

- The students are required to choose - **two disciplines**, (e.g. History or Economics or Physics or Mathematics) and an additional discipline (e.g. Music or Sports or Geography). Students gain deep knowledge through theory and practical experiences in their area of specialization. They gain a reasonable understanding of the area of additional study.
- Students can choose **subject combinations across 'streams'** (e.g. a student can choose a 'major' in physics and combine it with a 'minor' in History or Music or Sports). One of the disciplines can also be a **Vocational subject or Teacher Education**.
- The students may study two disciplines at the same level up to the sixth semester and choose one of them in the fourth year to obtain the Honours degree.
- A student who wishes to get **dual honours degrees may repeat the fourth year of the program in the second discipline**.

- **Skills shall be explicitly integrated, highly visible, taught in context, and have explicit assessment. The skills shall include abilities in language and communication, working in diverse teams, critical thinking, problem solving, data analysis and life skills.**
- **Students shall be given options to choose from a basket of courses which the institution is offering. There shall be no rigidity of combination of subjects.**
- **The Four-Year Choice Based Credit System Semester Scheme makes the product of a University at par with the global practices in terms of academic standards and evaluation strategies.**
- **In the scenario of Internationalization of Indian Higher Education, it is imperative that the Universities in India should follow this system so that the mobility of their products both within and across the geographical jurisdiction becomes possible.**
