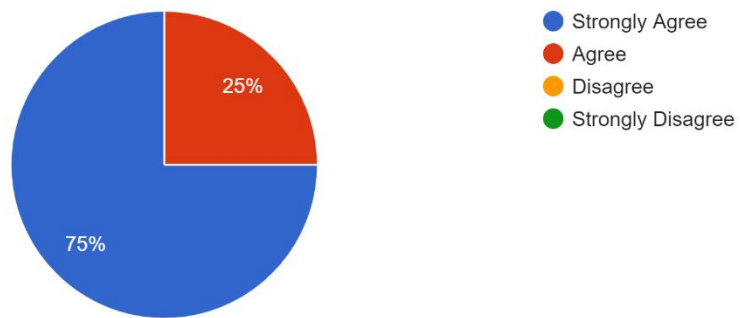
Most of the teachers were satisfied with the various aspects of teaching aids, other facilities provided in the college. Some of the teachers have urged to fully review the syllabus.
