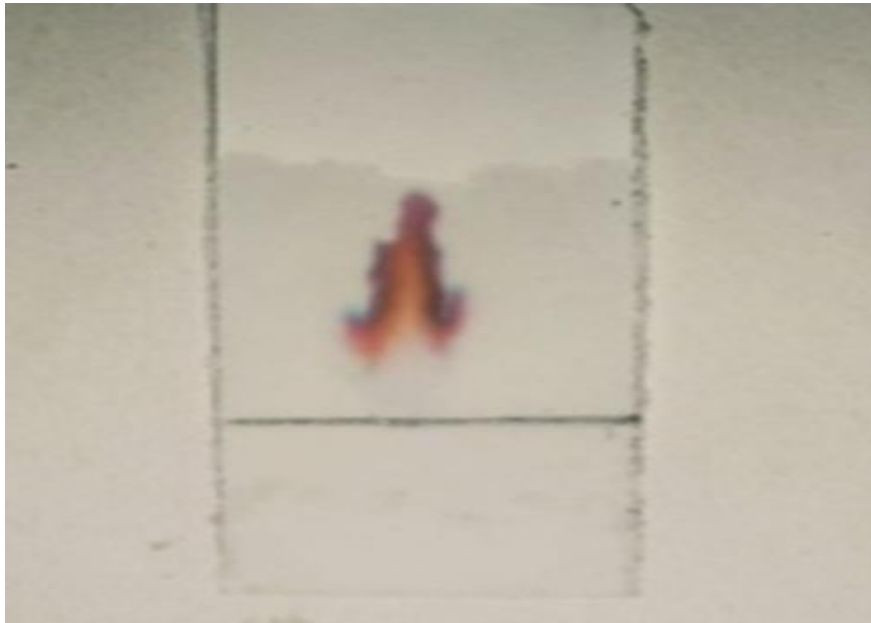

A British weigh scale is a device to measure weight or mass. There are also known as a British weigh scale, mass balance, weight balance, or simply weight balance, or balance scale. It is used to read the weight on a digital scale, but the other models of physical scales, called "beam balance scales," require you to do a little work and a lot of math. These scales work on the same principle. The beam of the balance is fixed on a pivot. You move weights along one side of the beam until it balances and is level. When the beam is level, the position of the weights shows your weight.

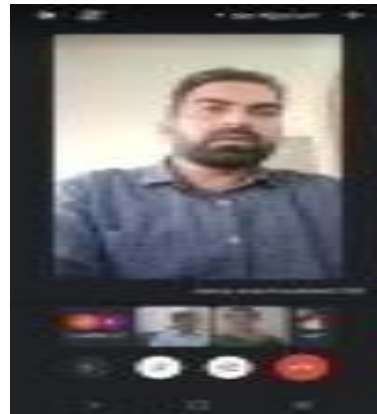

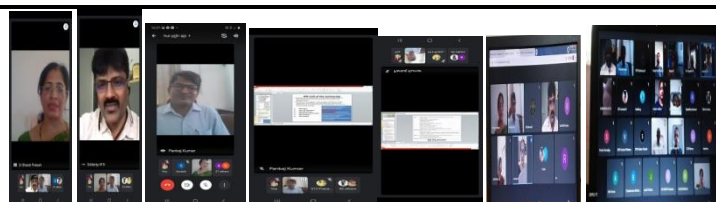

Mangalore: Akashvani never worked like an island. Working as a bridge between the system and the end user, the radio has been able to hear the pulse of the people,” said Hassan Akashvani Program Producer Keshav Murthy.

Delivering a special lecture during an online program hosted by the Journalism Department of the University College Mangaluru on Saturday, he said, The Akashvani, which had dominated the electronic media industry till 1980s, has also understood the need of new generation. 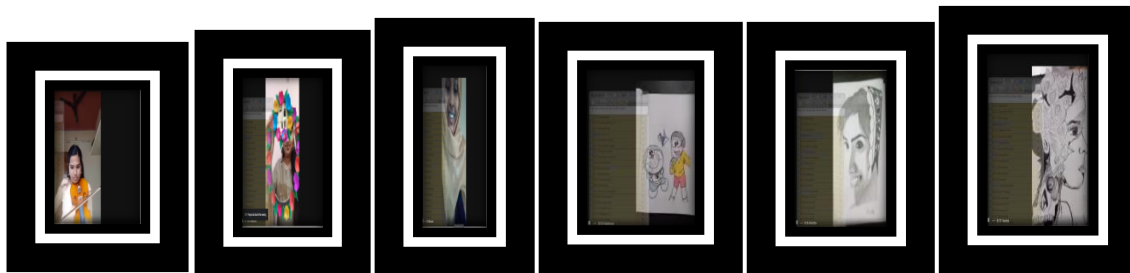
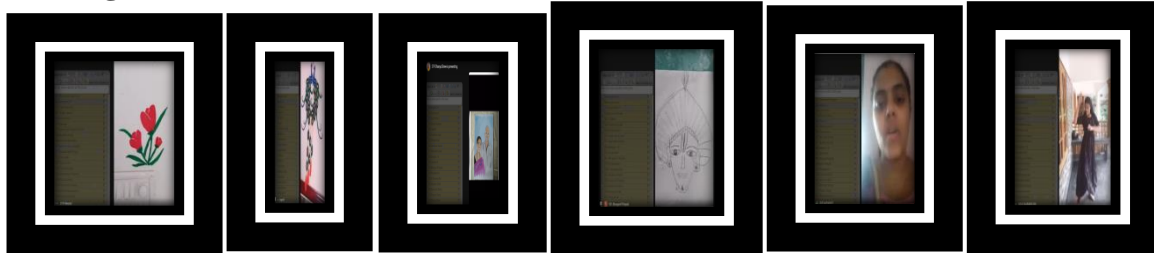

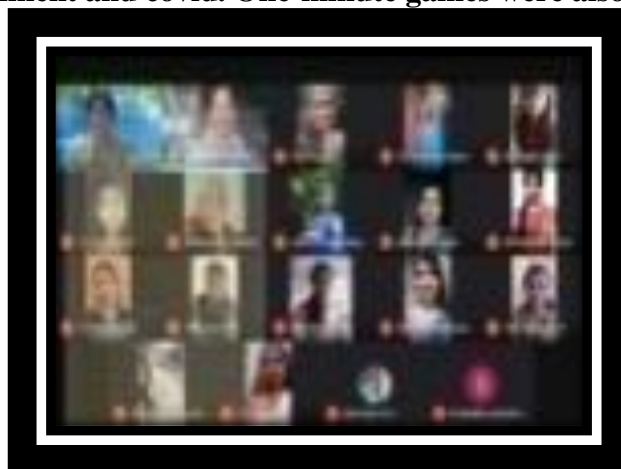
