






How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 384 responses




What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching. 387 responses






How well were the teachers able to communicate? 386 responses




The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 386 responses



Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers 386 responses




Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 387 responses
















The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth




