Dr. Suresh IQAC Coordinator extended welcomed all the members. After analyzing the feedback collected about the curriculum of the programmes from the stakeholders, the IQAC has noticed the following opinions and suggestions given by the stakeholders:

- 1. Most of the Students were satisfied with the various aspects of teaching like coverage of syllabus in class, emphasis on fundamentals, coverage of modern/advanced topics and overall course. Suggestions were received from some students regarding the upgradation of curriculum suitable to current needs.
- 2. More than 75% of the Teachers are satisfied with the number of optional papers in the course/programme, programme outcomes and curriculum with good academic flexibility. Some teachers have suggested to fully review the syllabus suitable for current trends.
- 3. Some of the Alumni have suggested that
  - The Campus selection for jobs, providing internship opportunities, career related programmes need to be improved
  - Science block should be renovated
- 4. Since some Employers have expressed their opinion to fill the gap between industry needs and existing curriculum. The IQAC has decided to bring these suggestions to the notice of the University for further action. The IQAC has also recommended to include an industry representative as BOS member so that he/she can contribute regarding the industry needs at the time of framing the curriculum.
