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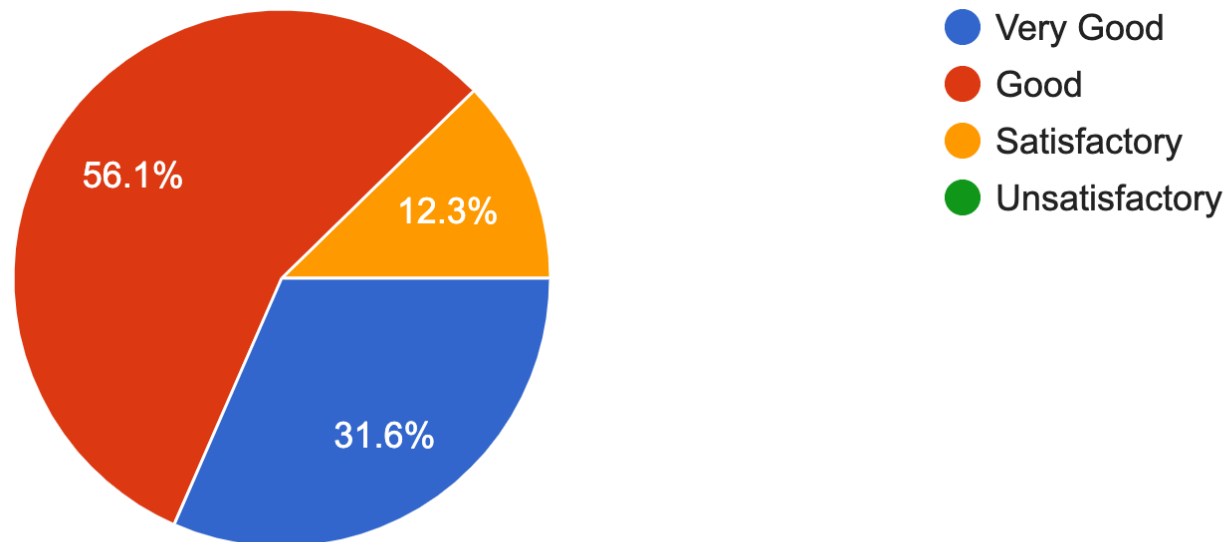

1. Depth of the course content

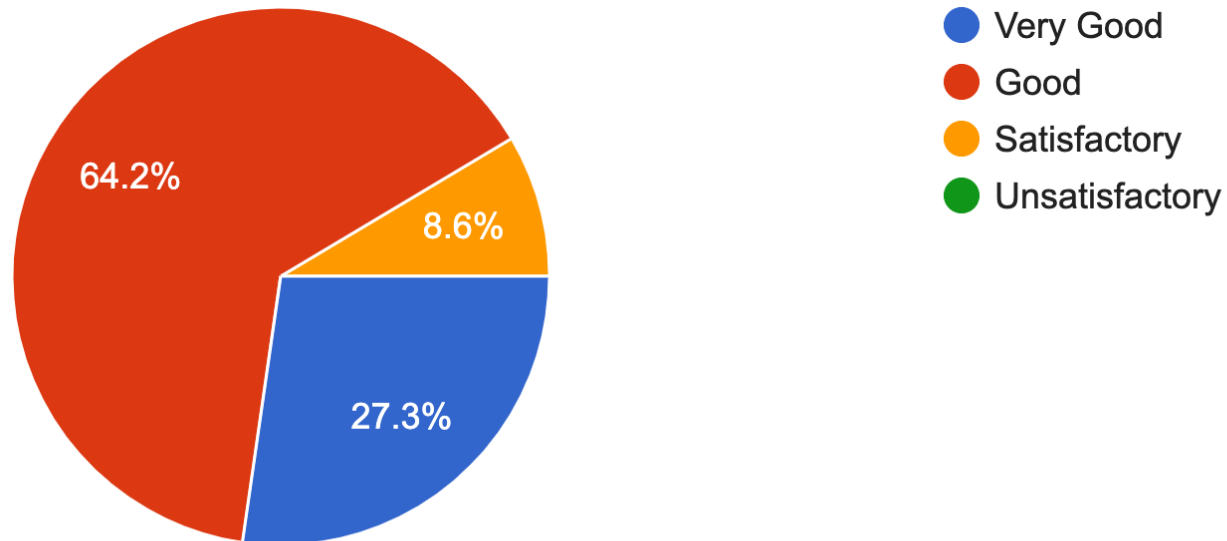

2. Extent of coverage of the course

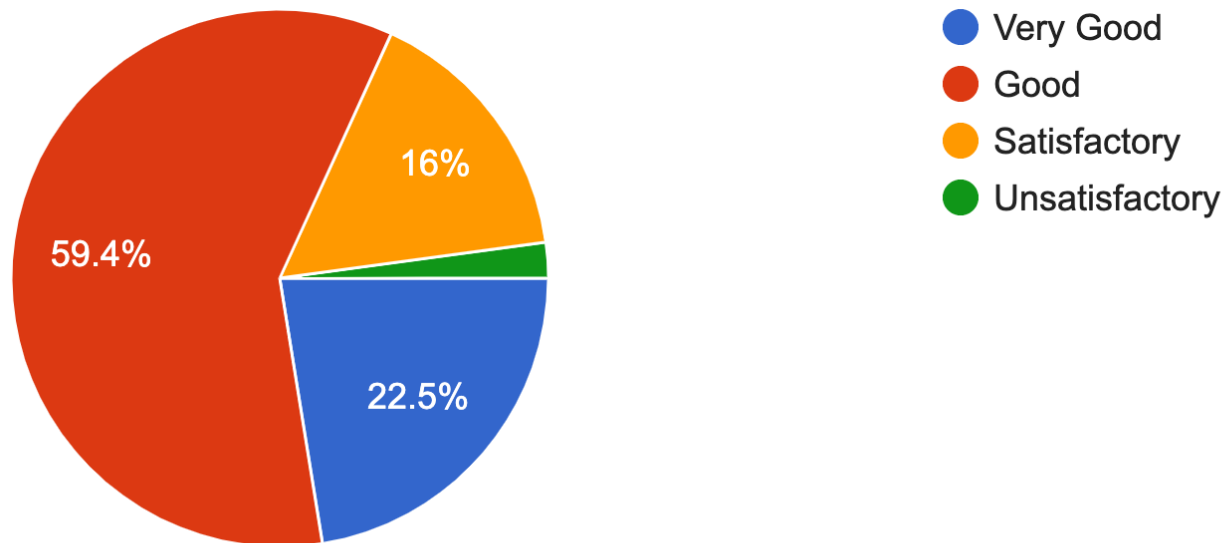

3. Applicability/relevance to real life situations

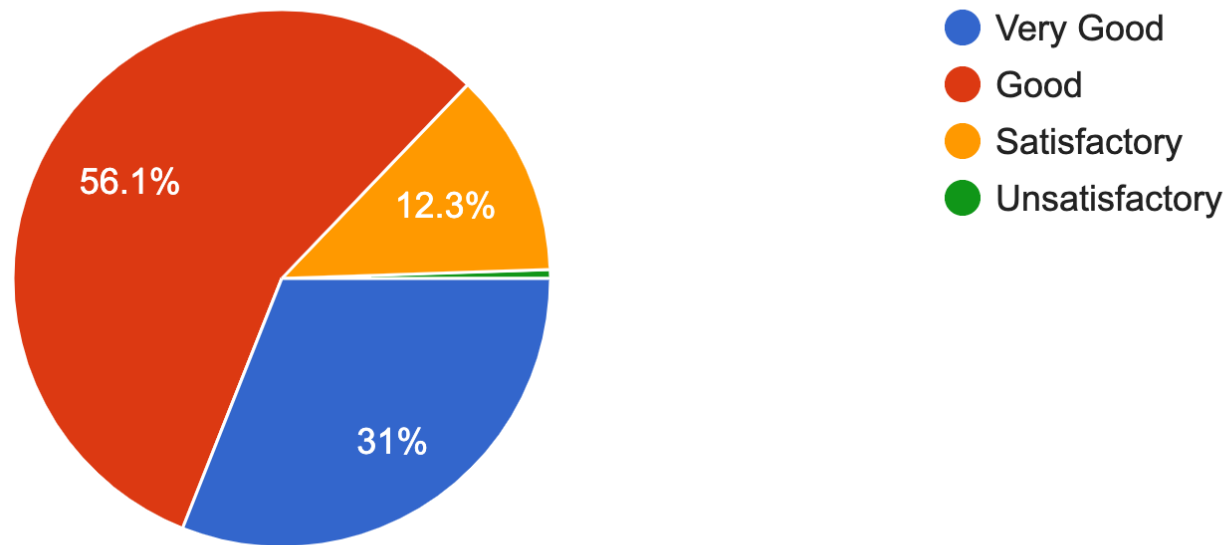

4. Learning value (in terms of knowledge' concepts, manual skills, analytical abilities and broadening perspectives)

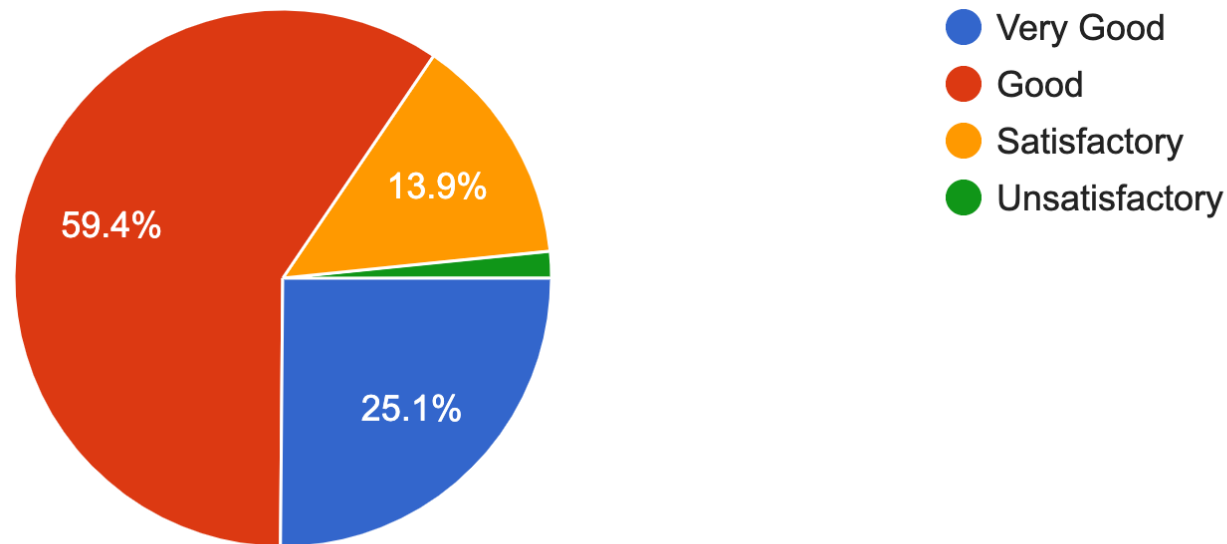

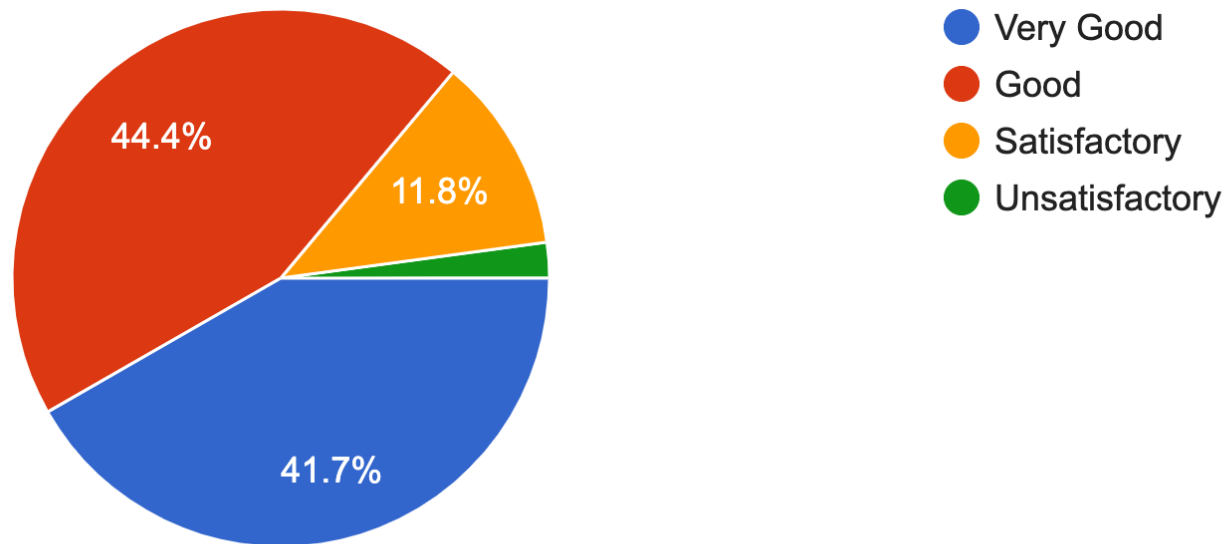

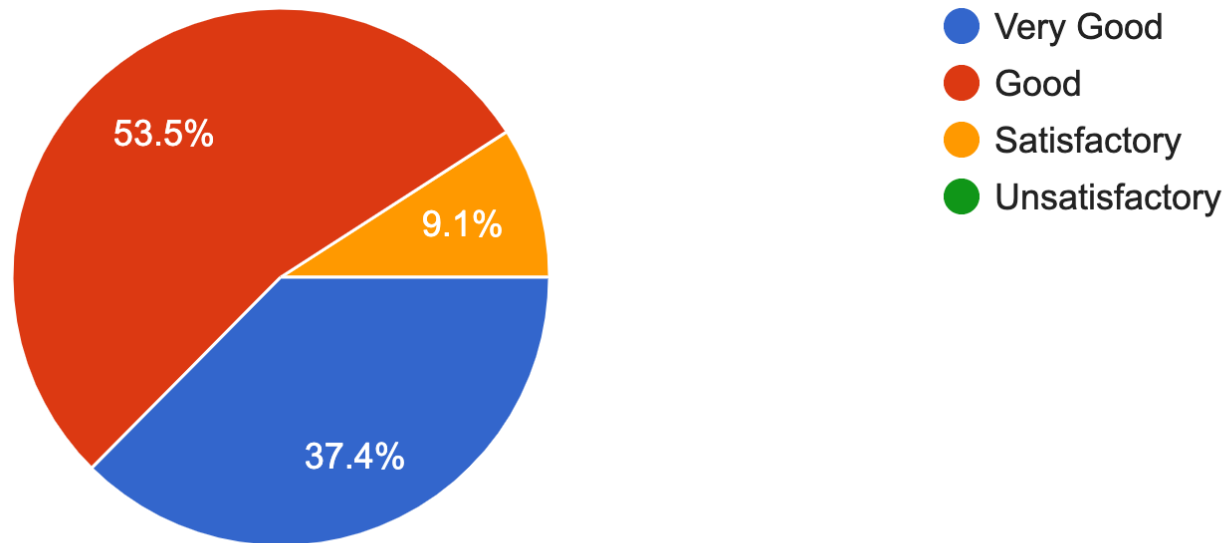

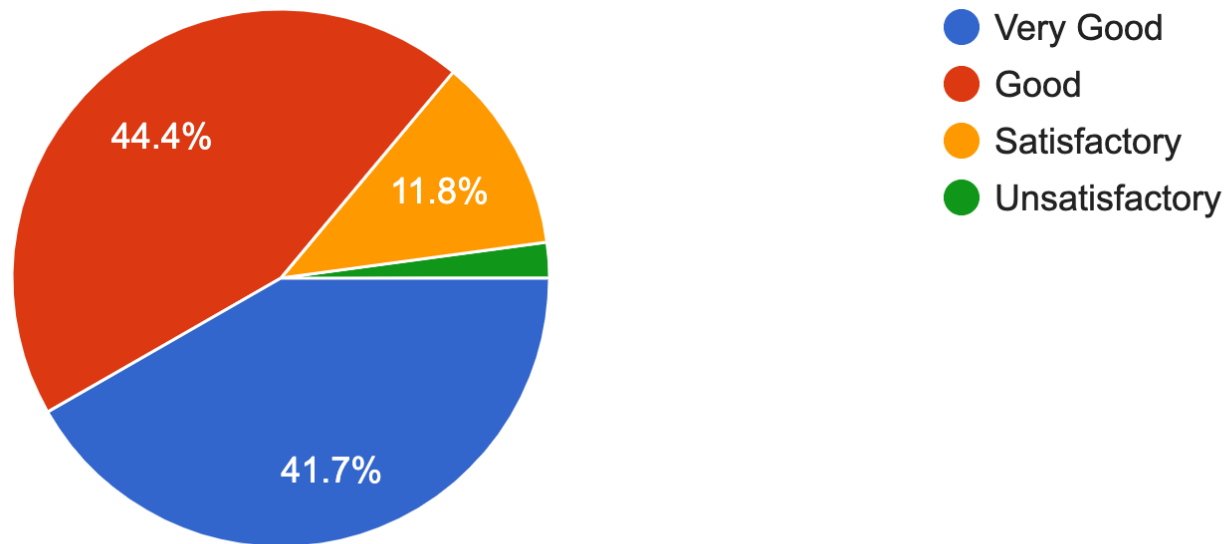

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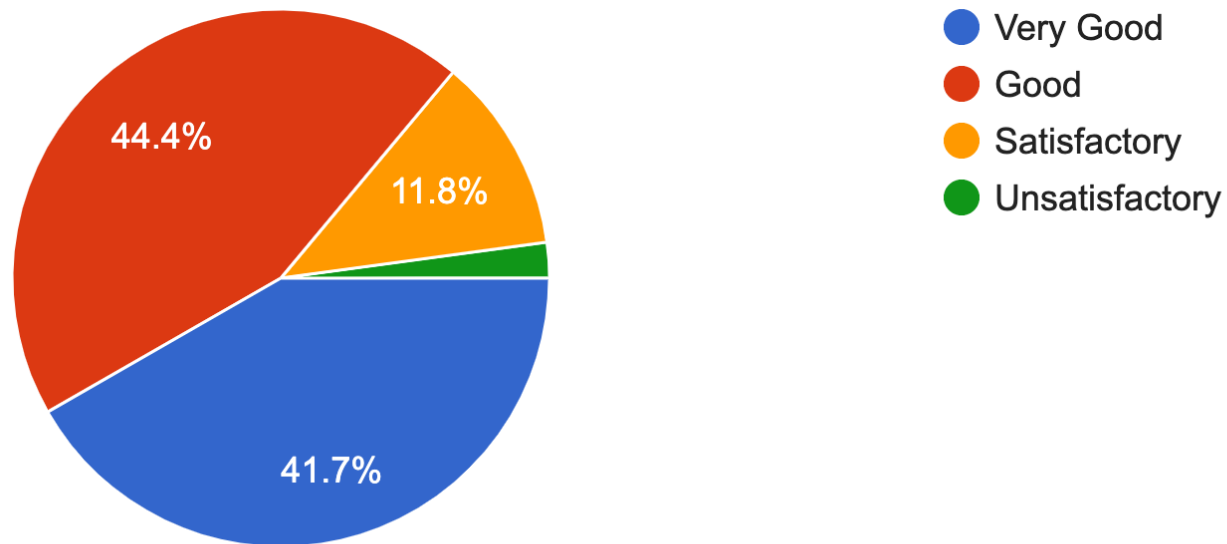

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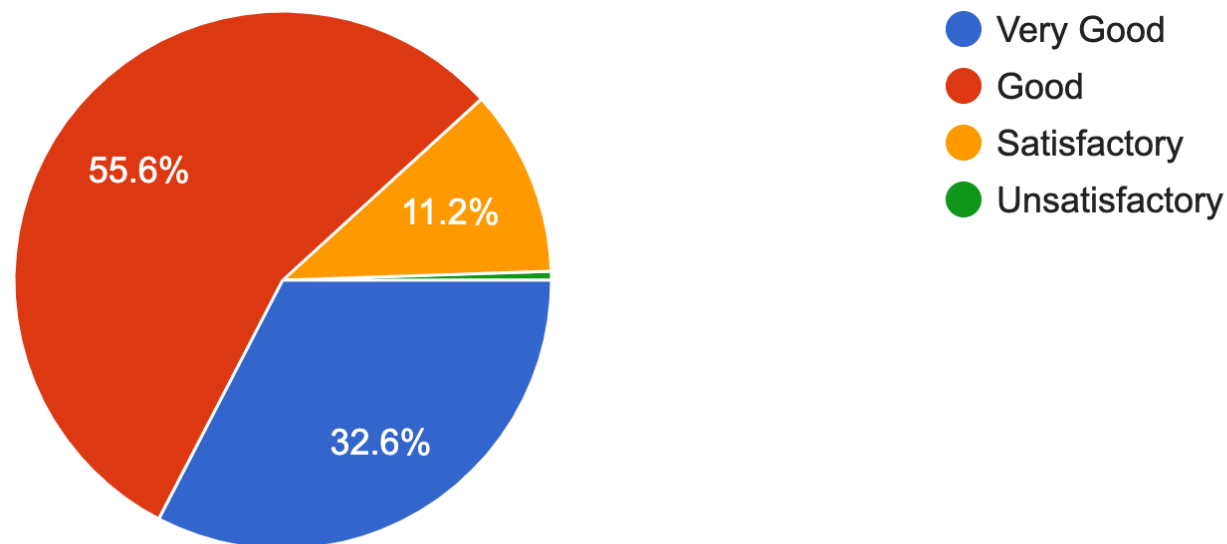

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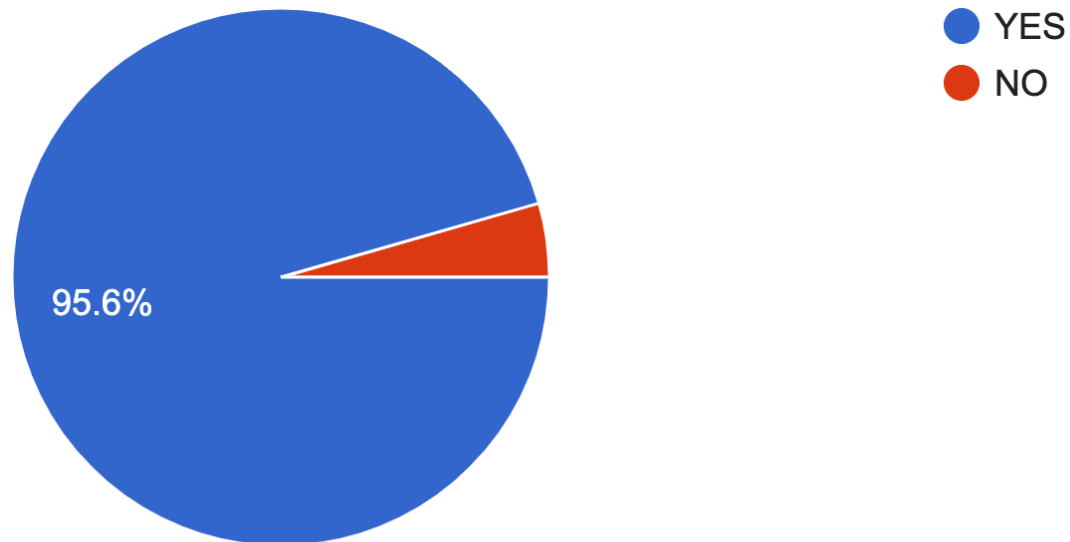

Was the degree course helpful in getting employment/ higher studies?

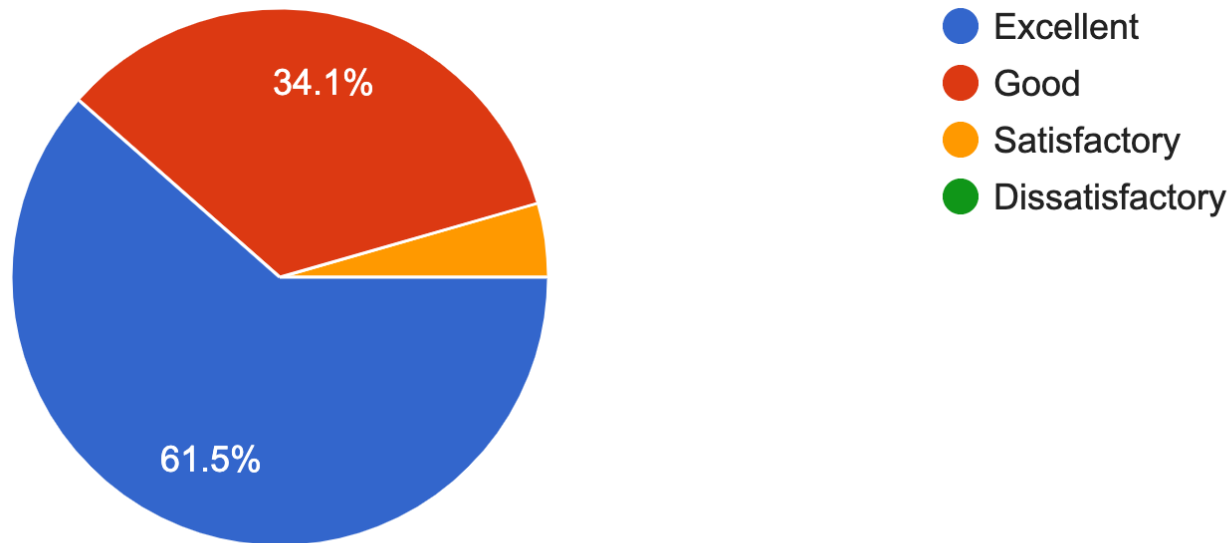

What is your opinion about the academic environment (teaching) in the college?

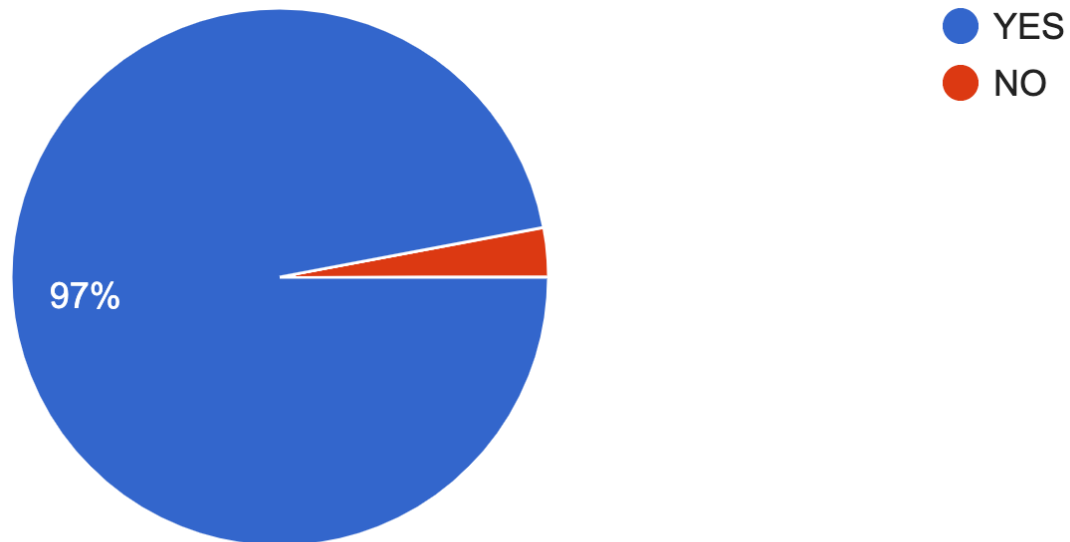

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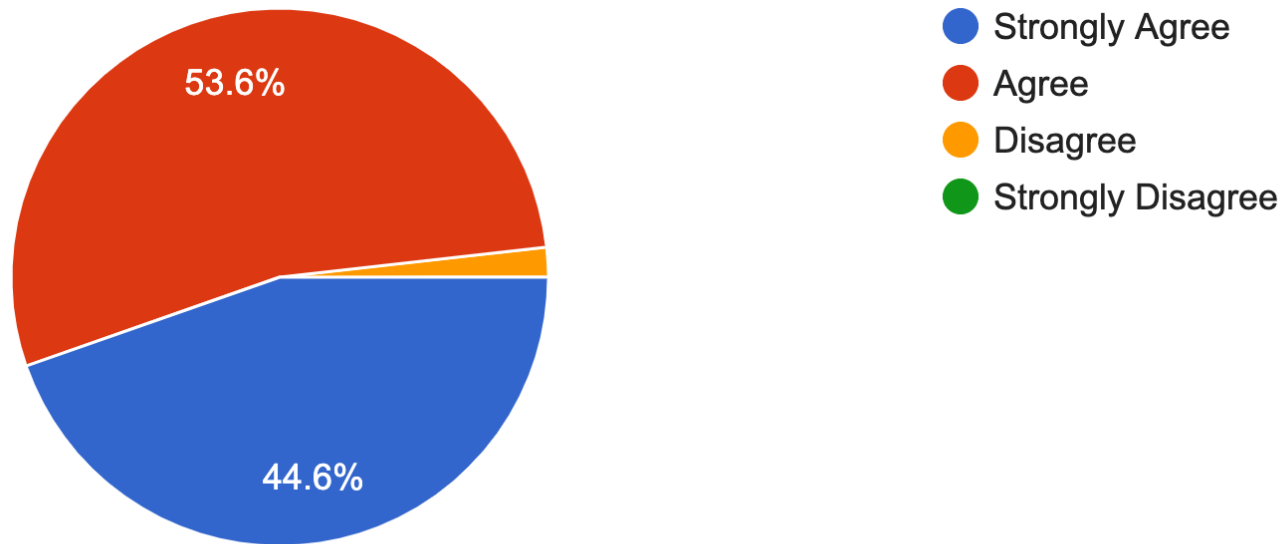

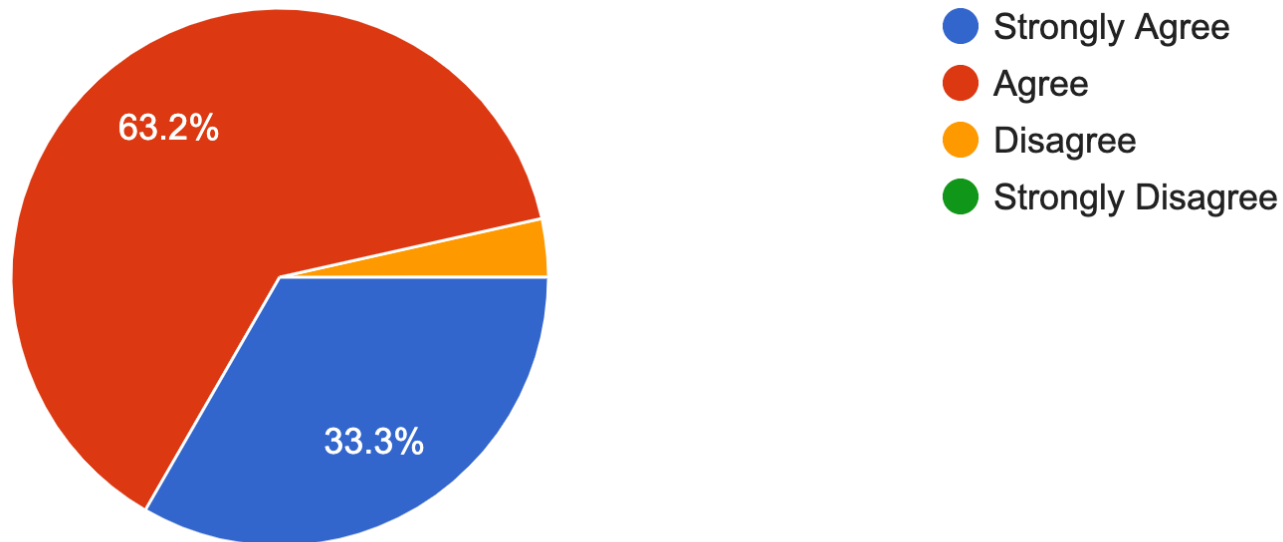

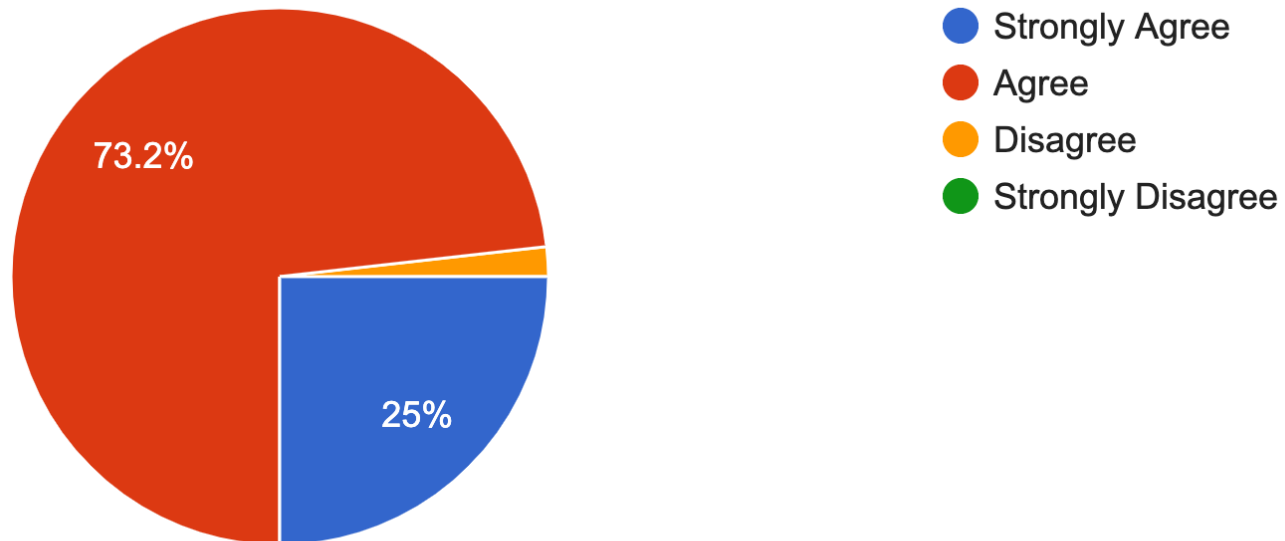

Programme outcomes of the syllabi is well defined

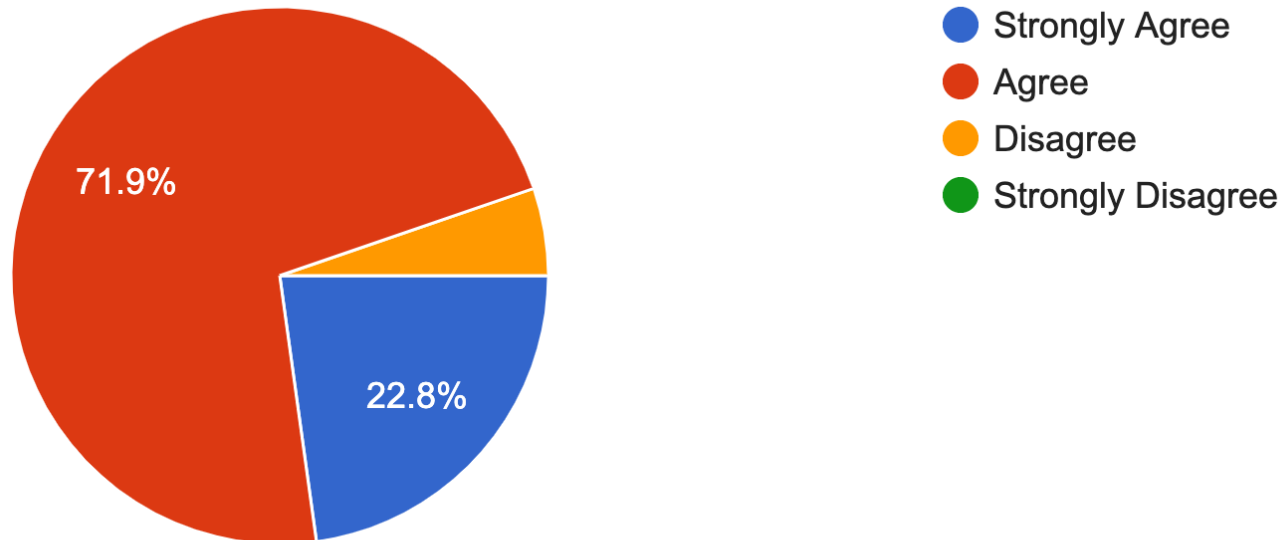

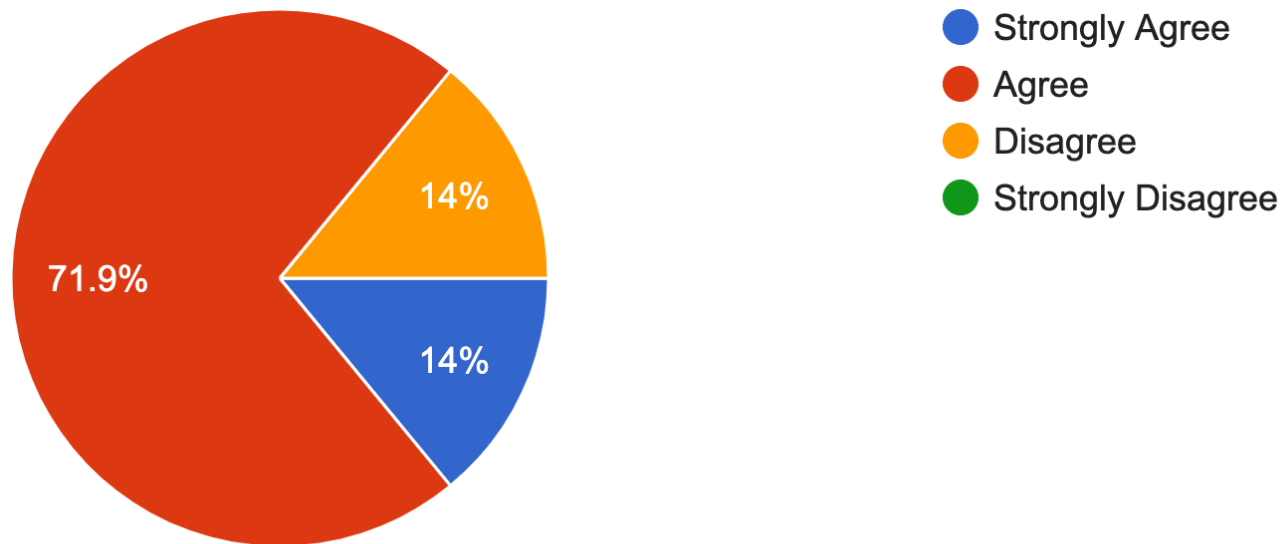

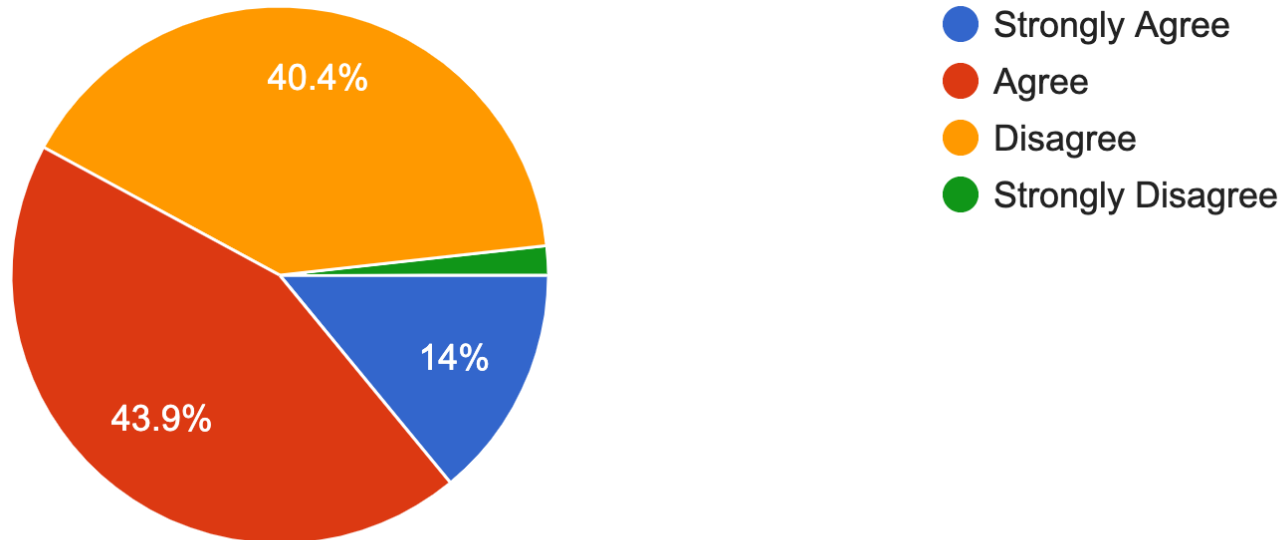

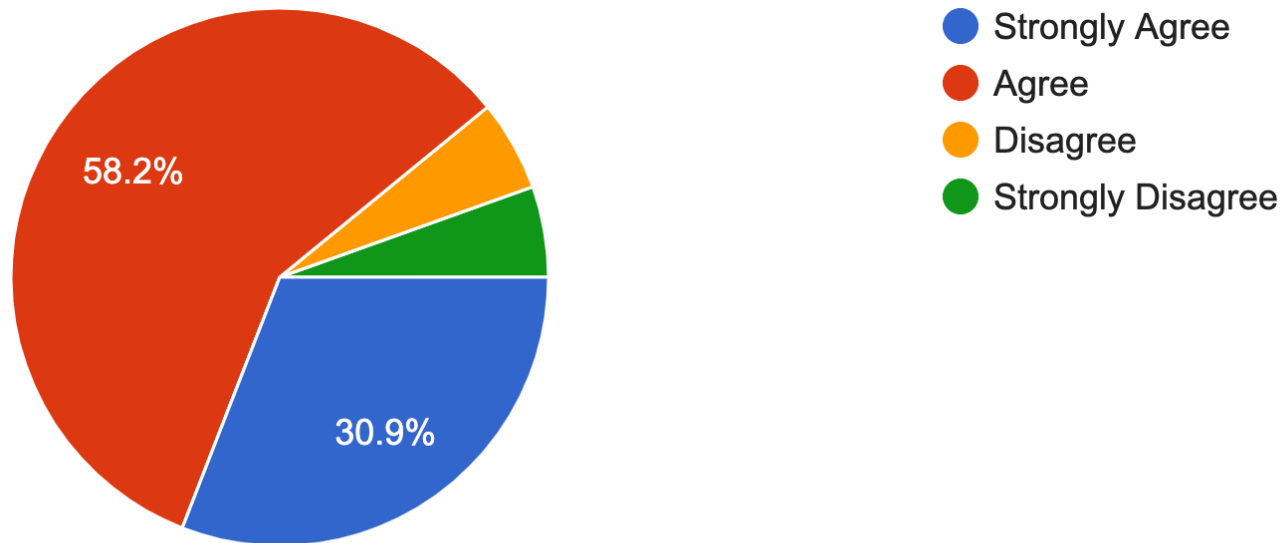

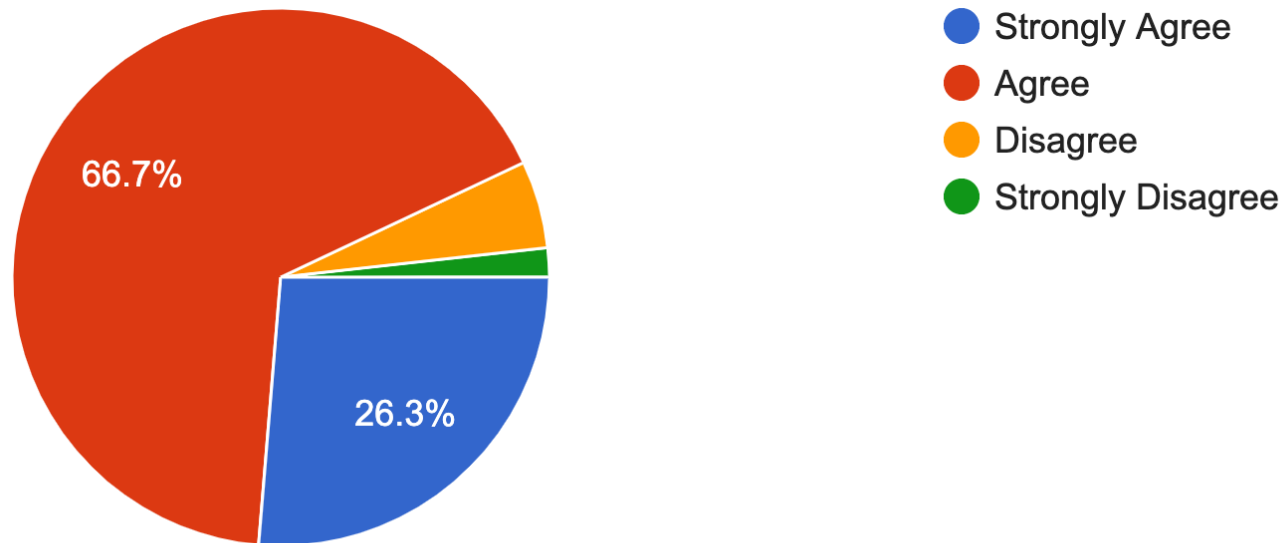

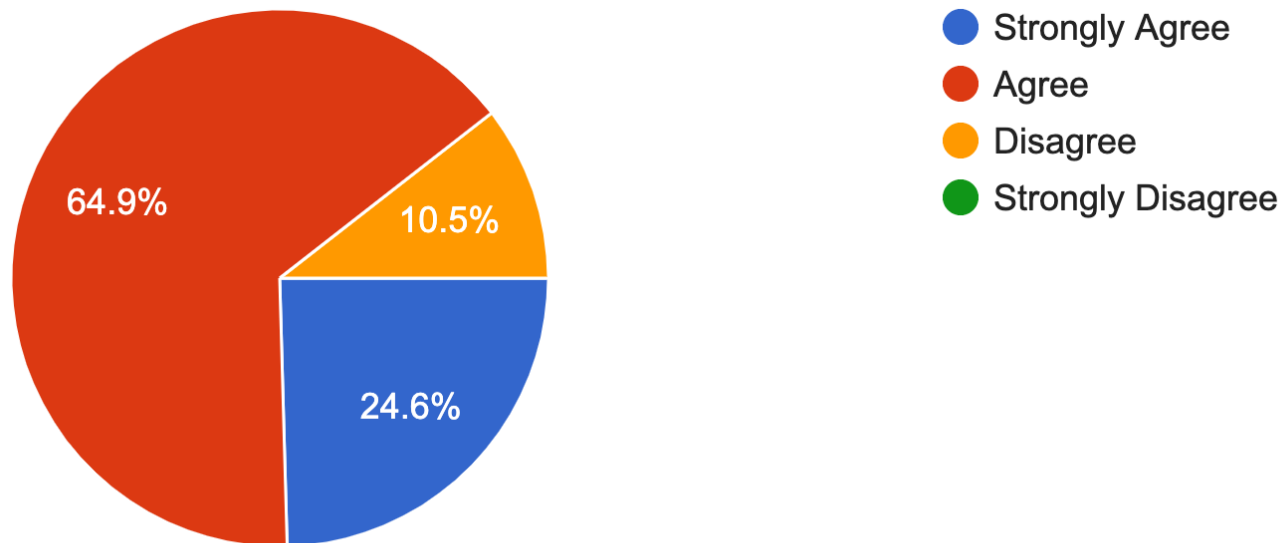

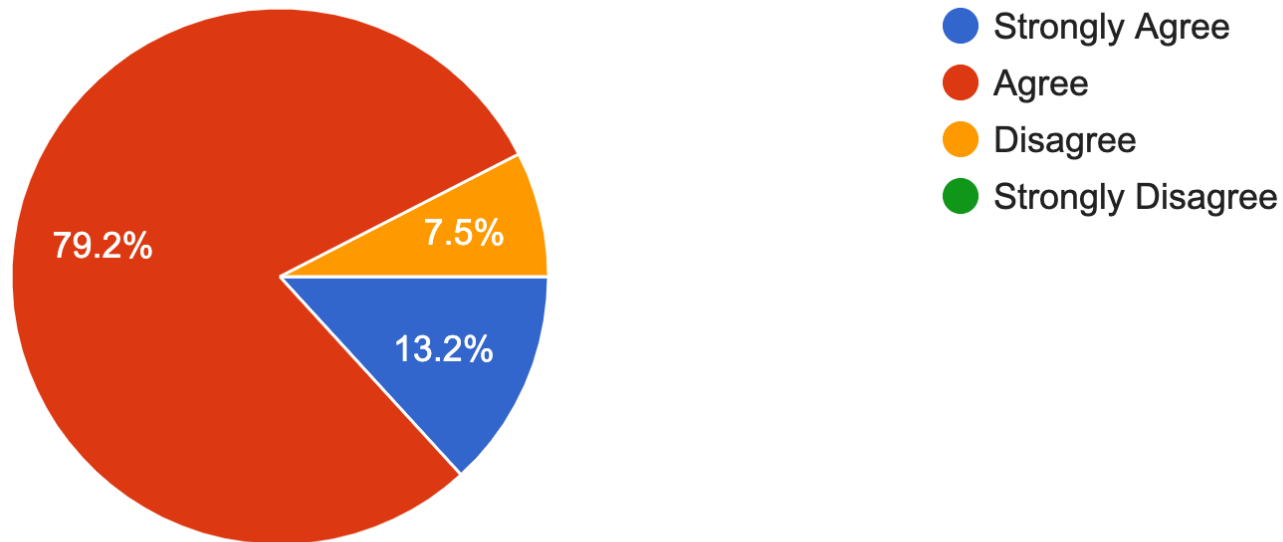

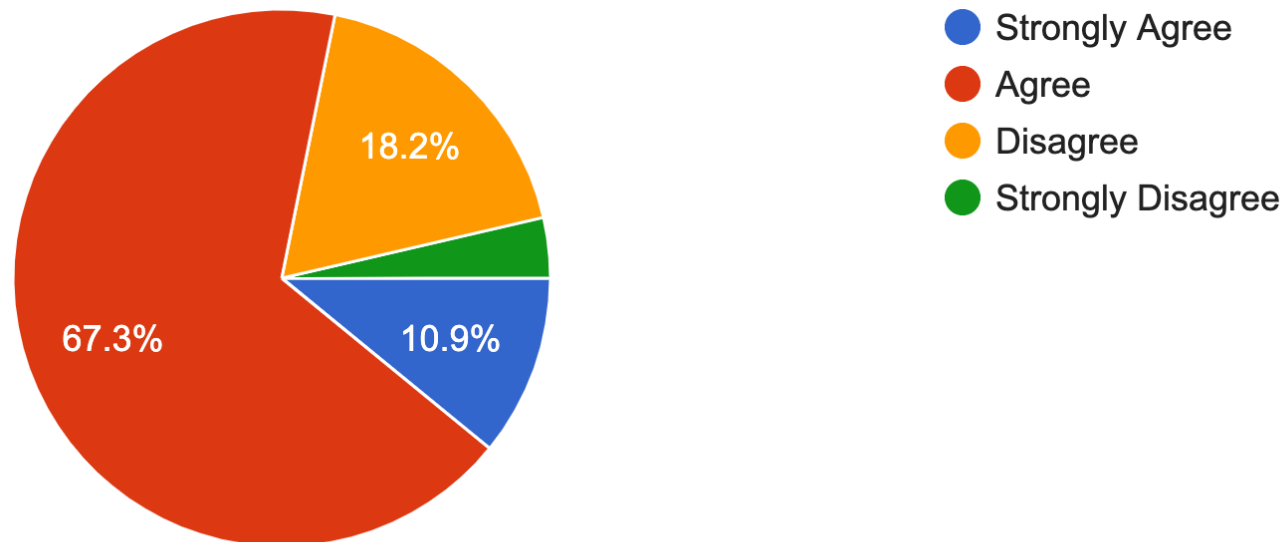

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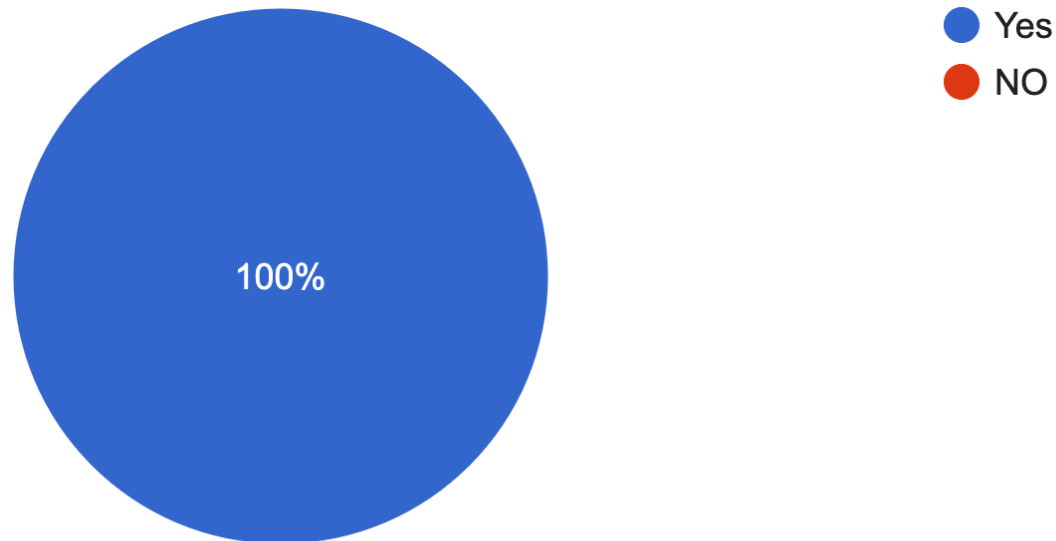

4. Has the degree course (curriculum) helped them in their workplace?

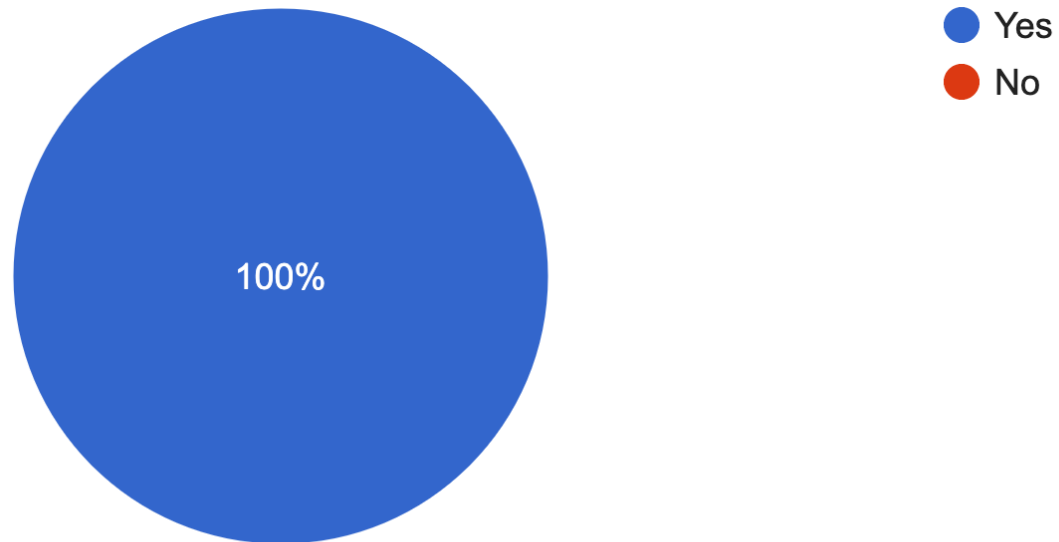

5. Do they shoulder the given responsibilities successfully?

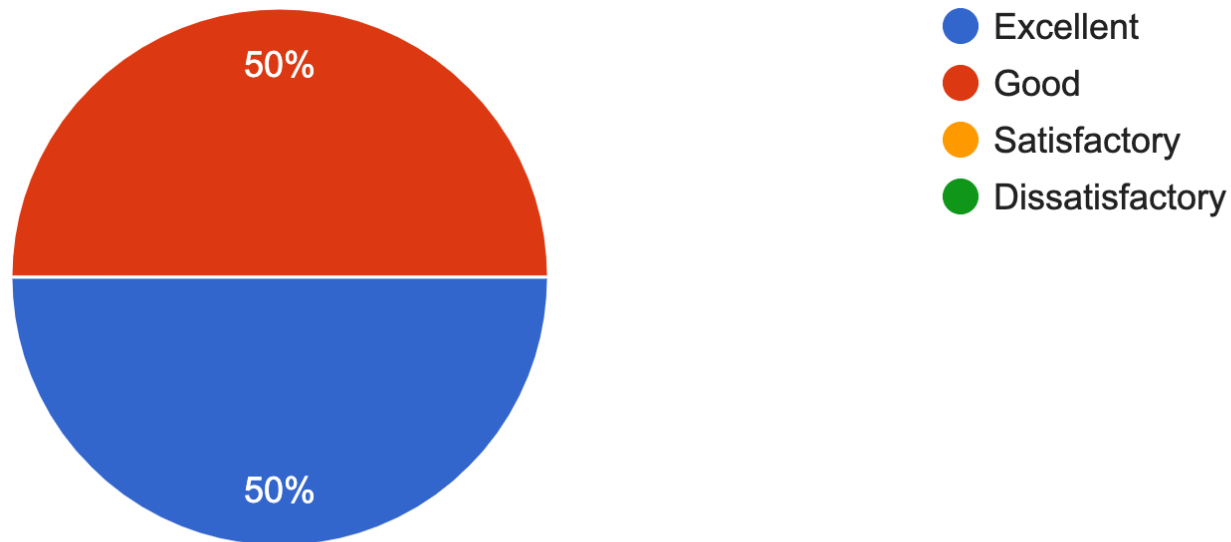
