The college has implemented specific regulations—such as mandatory reporting procedures and the formation of an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)—to address and prevent sexual harassment in accordance with the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. The institution's initiatives for sensitisation, prevention, and redressal aim to create a safe, secure, and gender-equitable campus environment that respects the dignity and rights of every student and staff member, as required by the UGC. These measures are legally mandated under the POSH Act, 2013, and the UGC Regulations, 2015.

Prevention Activities

Prevention focuses on taking proactive steps to stop incidents of sexual harassment before they occur. The institution ensures a safe and respectful campus by enforcing clear anti-harassment policies, maintaining secure infrastructure with gender-sensitive security, providing counselling and protection for those affected, and establishing accountability mechanisms that ensure timely action on ICC recommendations.

Redressal activities

Redressal mechanisms ensure that when incidents of harassment occur, complaints are addressed promptly, fairly, and sensitively to uphold justice for survivors. The college administers that an ICC (or equivalent) with internal, student, and external members to handle complaints. Reporting should be confidential and easily accessible, and the ICC must complete inquiries within 90 days, with the institution acting on recommendations within 30 days. The ICC can recommend disciplinary actions based on the severity of the offense, while providing immediate interim relief to the complainant, such as leave, department changes, or restrictions on the respondent, during the inquiry process. The role of sensitisation, prevention, and redressal goes beyond mere compliance; it reflects a continuous commitment to fostering this campus where every individual can thrive in a safe and harassment-free environment-which may be observed clearly in the vision statement of the college.
